Sport has always been central to the life of CFL athlete, Andrew Harris. He recognizes the important role that it created in providing him with a positive outlet as a young person, and was fortunate enough to turn his love of football into a highly celebrated career as a three-time Grey Cup Champion. He also understands the importance of giving back to the community. The No Barriers Award goes to a deserving young person in Manitoba in their grade 12 year of high school.

This bursary will cover the cost of registration for the recipient's choice of athletics or arts programming up to \$1,000. If within the value of the award, other associated fees may be considered (e.g., equipment or tournament fees). Program choice might include but is not limited to an Ultimate Frisbee league, flag football, golf lessons, dance programming, a visual arts camp, etc. Program registration must be before December 31st, 2022.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be Manitoba residents currently enrolled in grade 12. They must have been involved in community or volunteer work during their high school career. (Not limited to current year due to pandemic.)

QUALIFICATIONS

Enrolled in Grade 12 at a Manitoban high school.

Community involvement within the past three years.

Demonstration of financial need (This will be endorsed by school/community contact.

No additional information will be requested to demonstrate financial need.)

HOW TO APPLY

Submit a video (3 minutes max.) or a letter (3 pages max.) that discusses how sport/arts and community involvement have made a positive impact on your life, and how this award would help you overcome barriers to being involved in sports/arts programming after high school. The award committee will review all applications. Awards will be based on current enrolment in school and community. One scholarship is to be awarded annually in early June. Only fully completed applications will be considered.

SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATE

The successful candidate will be notified via email and will have until December 31st, 2022 to register for a program. Payment can be made directly to the organization being registered for.
